I am pleased to report that our annual book sale made a profit of around \$10,000 whilst the raffle earned a profit of about \$1,700.

It was decided at the board meeting to assist the victims of the Haiti earthquake by immediately buying three Shelter Boxes, two from 200 club money and one from donations. Additionally we will hold a bucket collection on the morning of Thursday, January 28. This will follow publicity in the Camden Haven Courier on the 27th. This will require as many Rotarians as possible. All moneys collected will be used to purchase further shelter boxes.

The board also decided to support the School of St Jude

by sponsoring a teacher and eight boarders for one year.

More than 3,300 Shelterboxes have been committed so far, enough to help up to 33,000 people. Given the enormity of the disaster, more boxes are being packed ready to be sent to the Caribbean country. Shelterbox Founder and CEO Tom Henderson added, "The need in Haiti is huge. Current estimates are that there are over a million people who have lost their homes. We continue to rely on the support of volunteers and donors. Planeloads of medical supplies, generators and water makers are also in transit on 5 aircraft temporarily donated to RI
